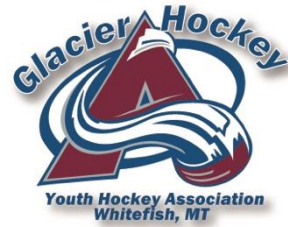

A. Public comment: Greg Harms attended the meeting.

B. Old/New Business

This meeting was called in response to the Governor's recent mandate to limit gatherings to 25 people or less. The phase at the beginning of the season was 50 at the rink. Youth community activities were more relaxed so that high school sports could continue. Governor Bullock's exemption allowed youth hockey to continue under this umbrella.

Mike Quinn brought this up to the Governor this morning and will be coming up with a statement about youth sports. We are looking for some directives in writing in order to proceed.

As far as we understand at this moment, we can have 50 people on the ice. We need to plan for Pee wee B and Bantam having teams coming here this weekend. We also have a team leaving town.

Liz recommended that we do the right thing. Keep our numbers to 25 members spectating.

Liz, Ryan, and Clint suggested that we cancel Yeti for this week. We need to get our policy outlined on spectators.

Pee wee Yeti have missed out on 3 weeks of Yeti. Twice due to Kalispell being shut down and once due to a Pee wee Quarantine.

Greg stated that there are some excellent opportunities for Pee wee to get more ice time as the season proceeds. Greg said the ice can be used for Yeti until June.

Greg will sell the Friday night ice so GHA will not have to pay for it.
